

Protocols for COVID-19 at ALC Kick Off Ride

Proof of Vaccinations & ID Checks

Registered participants will be required to show a proof of COVID-19 vaccination along with a valid Photo ID in order to check-in for the event.

- Full vaccination is defined as having had your 2nd shot, if a Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or your 1st shot, if Johnson & Johnson, no later than **Saturday, October 2, 2021**
- Acceptable forms of proof of vaccination include:
 - CDC-issued COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card
 - Photocopy or photograph of the Vaccination Record Card on a mobile device
 - Vaccine Proof provided by California Department of Public Health - either within the Wallet on a phone, a photo/screen grab, etc.

Masking & Social Distance Policies for Outdoor Events

- Masks are **REQUIRED for Cyclists** in the following places:
 - In any event vehicle with more than one person
 - Indoors at any location
 - In any event space that does not provide adequate ventilation of the air
- Masks are **REQUIRED for Staff, Volunteers, and Roadies** during shifts
 - While in event vehicles with more than one person
 - Indoors at any location
 - In any event space that does not provide adequate ventilation of the air
- Masks are **RECOMMENDED for all individuals**:
 - When social distancing cannot be maintained
 - In congregate settings, including camp and rest stops
- Social distancing at all sites is encouraged whenever feasible, and event sites will be set up with social distancing in mind

COVID-19 Mitigation Measures at Event Sites

AIDS/LifeCycle will be following COVID-19 safety plans developed within the guidelines from the CDC and California Department of Public Health. The following protocols will continue to be updated at the time of the event based on the evolving guidance issued by these agencies.

Health & Safety Protocols & Procedures

- Hand sanitizer and sanitizing wet wipes will be available throughout the event, at all starting locations and all rest stops
- Surfaces (such as tables, port-o-potty handles, interactive signage, etc.) will be regularly cleaned & sanitized
- Replacement surgical masks will be available for any individual who has lost, forgotten, or damaged their mask

Food Service & Beverage Distribution Areas

- Areas where food is consumed will be spread out to support social distancing

Protocols for COVID-19 at ALC Kick Off Ride

- Signage will be posted to remind people about mask wearing, stopping the spread of germs, and recommending social distancing
- Volunteers will be required to wash their hands and use food service gloves while handling food or beverages during their shifts
- Individually-wrapped snacks will be available, in addition to cut bananas and oranges

Portable Toilets

- Signage will be posted to remind people about hand washing and recommending social distancing
- Hand sanitizer and hand wipes will be available outside the port-o-potty units, and hand-washing sinks will be available at port-o-potty stations only
- Sanitizing wipes will be provided for people to wipe down chairs, seats, etc.

COVID-19 Mitigation Measures on Route

Start / Finish

- Ride Out from each starting location will occur as normal, and riders will be encouraged to space themselves out in line to allow for social distancing

Rest Stops

- Signage will be posted to remind people of social distancing, hand washing, as well as stopping the spread of germs
- When appropriate (such as in a rest stop food service line), lanes of travel will be designated for food, beverage, and other places people may wait in lines
- Port-o-Potties - handwipes and hand sanitizer will be available outside the port-o-potty units, and handwashing stations will be available outside the units as well
- Sanitizing wipes will be available for wiping down toilet seats and other surfaces as needed

SAG/Support Vehicles

- Masks are required to be worn while inside all event vehicles and windows will be rolled down as weather conditions permit
- Masks will be provided for participants in support vehicles if they have lost or damaged their mask

On the Bike

- Masking is not required while participants are actively riding their bikes
